**Deadline:** Jan. 31, 2012

As part of the People's Prayer Breakfast, on Thursday, February 2, 2012 simultaneous to the annual National Prayer Breakfast in Washington, Occupy Faith DC seeks submissions of artwork by children and young people. Works should illustrate what life can be like if citizens work together so that there is "enough for everyone". Submissions from individual children and youth, families, religious schools, and neighborhood groups welcomed, including:

Drawings	Paintings
Photography	Illustrated passages from sacred texts
Calligraphy	Collages
Two-dimensional media	Decorated original poems & writings
Graphic Storyboards/Comics	Illustrated quotations from respected voices of faith

Images might portray economic inequality moving toward a society with enough for everyone. Consider realistic and imaginary visions as well as evocative abstract interpretations. In addition to material things, "enough" may include other ideas such as warm homes, schools, music and art, food and health, or a sense of belonging.

17 X 22 inches, horizontal or landscape

*Please write "Online OK" on the back of each image, initialed by both the artist and an authorized supervising adult.*

**Art Forms:** Any two-dimensional medium, including but not limited to: paint, pastel, crayon, collage, digital graphics, photographs. Please fix unstable media, such as pastel. If possible, please create the work on a semi-stiff or stiff poster stock, or mount in on poster stock prior to delivery.
