



Election Calendar & Voter Registration Information

IOWA

Last day to register to vote by mail	Saturday, October 27
Last day to register to vote online or in person	Saturday, October 27
Online registration	Yes - you need an Iowa ID to use Iowa's online voter registration system. If you don't have an Iowa-issued ID, you can still register to vote by mail.
Early voting days	None. Can vote early by absentee ballot
Last day to apply for and return an absentee ballot	Saturday, October 27—Absentee ballots received in the county auditor's office by the time the polls close on election day are eligible for counting. Absentee ballots received after the polls close on election day must be postmarked by the Monday before election day or earlier and received in the county auditor's office no later than noon on the Monday following the election.
Election Day	Tuesday, November 6, 2018
Election Day Hours	7:00am-9:00pm
Can voters register to vote at the polls during early voting and on Election Day with a special ballot?	Iowa offers the opportunity to register to vote on Election Day. To register on Election Day, voters must go to the polling place for their current address and show proof of identity and residency. If you cannot prove who you are or where you live, another voter from your precinct may attest for you.
Who is eligible to vote?	To register in Iowa you must: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • be a citizen of the United States • be a resident of Iowa • be at least 17-1/2 years old (you must be 18 to vote) • not have been convicted of a felony (or have had your rights restored) • not currently be judged by a court to be "incompetent to vote" • not claim the right to vote in more than one place • give up your right to vote in any other place
