 - In general, we did well this year on advocacy and education

- Motion to Amend the UUSJ Bylaws and Policies on Membership To eliminate Membership as Standing Committee, with associated amendment of policies
 - This size board is not equipped to staff 5 standing committees
 - Section 7.2 lists all standing committees need to drop reference to Membership committee
 - Section 7.7/7.7.1 description and duties of membership committee need to be removed the work can be done by development team or full board
 - Charlotte motions, Peggy seconds, all in favor
 - Approved unanimously by the board with more than a guorum present.
 - 10.1 Policy: Responsibilities of Each Category of Membership
 - Take out the responsibility of the Membership Committee
 - All in favor, approved

 - We need to build our brand.
 - Building relationships through fellowship and continuing communication throughout. Mariano
 - Spending the proper time to do onboarding of new trustees, including Conflict of Interest, etc. - Charlotte
