 - Some updates to be made based on feedbacks
 - Leading teams into a space of advoacy when needed, not adhering to a schedule
 - Continuing to see strong showing in the Immigration Action Team and Democracy Action Team
 - Reenergize the two other teams, Environmental Team and Economic Justice Team
 - Talking with Tammy Johnson Liberation Pathways, as well as UUCSJ for accountability and racial justice training.
 - Requirements for Tammy Johnson sessions
 - 3 90-minute training modules
 - How do we encourage our volunteers to take part in this?
 - A letter from the board?
 - Should we make this compulsory? Make it urgent and required but use "carrot" to entice
 - Communications Assistant Chloe, Paulette, and Pablo created a job description. Pablo will be posting the job description soon, and board will cross post to other places. Pablo to share job description with trustees.
