The Farm Bill is one of the most important pieces of legislation that Congress regularly reauthorizes, and the Supplemental Nutrition Assistance Program (SNAP) is a vital part of the Farm Bill. Through the SNAP program, Congress has the ability to combat hunger by strengthening essential programs; removing barriers to access for struggling individuals and families; and increasing access to affordable, nutritious foods to support good nutrition and health.

Cuts to essential safety net programs like SNAP will harm the most vulnerable members of society, including children, seniors, people with disabilities, and the unemployed. The program ensures that, even in the midst of the current economic climate, families will be able to meet their most basic need for food.

We need Congress to provide marginalized populations better access to SNAP by removing overly restrictive elements such as work requirements, immigrant bans, and time limits for adults without dependents.
