 - 10.5 out of 12 pieces regarding appropriations have yet to be touched
 - Farm Bill continuing resolution of some sort proposed within a week or so.
 Current leads want the Farm Bill done by the end of the year.
 - Conversation around Fentanyll is emerging as staffers look for a point of agreement between divides
 - Pablo is talking with our teams to help them understand now is the time for relationship building and "deep tissue advocacy"
 - A similar update is expected for October
 - Might see an escalation arc as we move into the new year
 - A couple of upcoming events
