The legislative proposals in both chambers articulate a massive restructure of our approach to human needs policy and programs in the U.S. They authorize a massive and unconscionable transfer of wealth from poor, low-income, and low-wealth households to wealthy and billionaire Americans. They do so in the form of resource and program reductions for the vulnerable and needy paired with a bonanza of tax cuts for the greedy.

The House proposal would cut \$880 billion from Medicaid and \$230 billion from SNAP (food stamps)—yes, billions—to give \$1.1 trillion—yes, trillion—in tax breaks to America's 1% wealthiest individuals.

- ~ Those are prescriptions gone from medicine cabinets, sea to shining sea.
- ~ It is medical care for families canceled, delayed, and denied border-to-border.
- ~ Those are staples swiped off the pantries in every corner of America.

Food prices are rising again these days and in 2024, SNAP provided benefits to 41 million Americans who needed a helping hand beyond what community projects and goodwill efforts can provide. The proposed cuts will force many families toward food insecurity, if not full on hunger.
